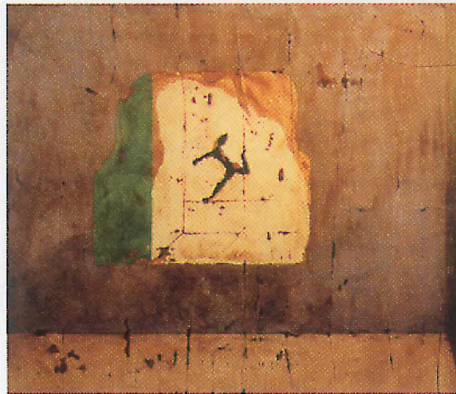


What's Hanging IN THE GALLERIES
